Applicants should have a background in Social Services. Good organizational skills and familiarity with a computer are important. The trainee will be paid a stipend while learning the job duties.

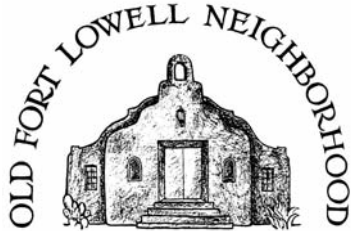
